

**Supply List**  
**for the Ice Dyeing and Super-fast super-low immersion dyeing**  
**with Veronica Von Zwehl**

**Participants bring:**

Scoured or PFD fabric, at least 6 quarter yard or half yard pieces for ice dyeing, and 20 to 30 fat quarters for immersion. To save time, please precut your fabric

5 gallon pail/bucket

Rubber gloves

1 roll of paper towels

Various sized zip lock bags, i.e. sandwich, quart and gallon—for wet fabrics

At least 6 to 8 jars (glass or clear plastic) about 8 to 14 ounces with screw tops, i.e. salsa, peanut butter, pickle, jelly jars. Small glass Heinz

gravy jars work the absolute best.

PFD fabric

Here are the details again:

You have 2 choices, both have a min order of 5 yards:

1 – Natures Way muslin by Roclon: \$1.60 per yard includes shipping

Many of our members use this muslin and like it very much. They recommend scouring it first (wash in HOT water with some soda ash and soap). It is

unbleached so it is a light beige and becomes somewhat 'suede like' after the dyeing process.

The beige color of the fabric produces a somewhat muted shade.

2 – Thompsons PFD: \$2.80 per yard includes shipping

This is a bleached cotton so it is white and produces a more vibrant color.
