Supply list:

Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies

Design wall or piece of fleece or flannel

Masking tape

Large cutting mat - size 23" x 17" recommended

Rotary cutter cutting rulers: 24" x 6" and a large square size 12" or 15"

Sketch pad size 11" x 14"

Tracing paper

Sharpie pens

Pencil for sketching

Pen and notepad for taking notes

Fabric and paper scissors

(optional) 'chalk type' pencils or fabric markers of some kind

Collect and bring to class pictures of art work, landscapes or images that you like. Use magazines, calendars, photos etc.

Fabric-

Solids, mottled, hand dyed, - fat quarter to one yard pieces with a good range of colors from light to dark - those dramatic ones that you haven't been able to cut into.

Include one to three yards of solid black cotton fabric
