



"The 20th Challenge"


*Participants will be randomly assigned a 20th century artist (i.e. Pablo Picasso).

May 2023 Board Meeting Minutes

May 5, 2023

Jef presented the proposed budget. We discussed it and approved it. Jef will present it to the

membership for voting in July. Candie suggested an announcement be made about the board members (four out of six) who were displaced because of the hurricane. Shannan bought signs AQU to let members know which building we are meeting in. We will vote on the bylaw changes at the general meeting. Jef had a notebook full of information about AQU. We should ask about someone becoming the historian. Lisa talked about retreat 2024. We will be back at Day Springs for four days. Lisa then told us about a proposed teacher, Natalya Khorkover, who works with single use plastics. She charges \$2,000 for a three day zoom class. Lisa asked Jef to sign the contract for a class in January 2024. Lisa also mentioned a trunk show by Yellow Brick Studio. Marci let the board know that the taxes will be filed timely. We had three guests, Kathy Bolen, "Mary" Cieba Gorski, and Ravee Ford. Lisa Gorski presented the program, making beads with paper, fabric, and cardboard. She gave us plenty of tips and demoed several shapes, including a woven bead. Beads can be finished with Aleen's, paper glaze, Mod Podge, or Dollar Tree nail polish. She uses half a pool noodle with the skewers to let the beads dry. The presentation was well received. Jef announced that the budget was approved in the board meeting and we will vote on it in July. Lisa announced the next retreat, Mary 21-25, 2024. Cost will be \$620 for a single room and \$460 for a double. In the works is a zoom class with Natalya Khorover January 21, 28, and February 4, 2024. She uses single use plastics to create architectural quilts. Holly passed out the brown bags. Ann Readon let us know that this is her last meeting as she will be moving to Amelia Island. We voted on the bylaw changes and approved. Candie had met with Joyce Murrin, an art quilter who has retired from quilting. She donated her stash to AQU and there was a wide selection of goodies for members to take. Marci will make a fabric thank you card for the members to sign. Jef reminded the membership that four of the board members were displaced as a result of the hurricane, but they still got the Guild work done.
